* The 3rd (or more) CMAA member from a club may pay FLCMAA's multi-member discount. The reduced rates apply only if the 1st and 2nd members from the same club have fully paid their 2010 dues.

** The Administrative Fee is paid only once, when an individual first joins the Association. When joining, this fee does not apply to Faculty, Student or Surviving Spouse membership classifications. Students converting to Provisional / Alumnus status are also exempt.

*** Associate Membership is available only to Active and Provisional members who leave the club management field, and retain their membership. One can not rejoin CMAA as an Associate Member.

Effective May 1 of each year, the Florida Chapter CMAA offers a 30% discount on dues for the 3rd quarter.

Note: 96% of all clubs pay for the CMAA member's yearly dues

New Members please provide two checks: one check payable to CMAA National for \$890 and one check payable to Florida Chapter CMAA for \$455. Both checks to be mailed to the FLCMAA office.

The FEC: Florida's Regional Education Club

Florida Chapter CMAA dues invoices incorporate a pre-paid "**Education Club**" fee, which covers registration for all regular regional Business & Educational meetings for the year. It does not include CMI Workshops, etc, or social events. The purpose of the "**FEC**" is to enable each region to maximize its ability to offer premier-quality education. Individuals may opt out of the program at their discretion. In such cases, the 1st or 2nd member paying full dues may deduct \$160 and remit \$295. In like manner, the 3rd or more members may deduct \$100 and remit \$205. NOTE: opting out of the FEC reduces funding for a member's own Region to develop its education schedule.
