Of the thousands tested, at least 13 cases of previously undetected breast cancer have been diagnosed and treated.

This year Morgan, St. Andrews Country Club's Resident Touring Professional, welcomed her fellow LPGA friends and players Paula Creamer, Cristie Kerr, Brittany Lincicome and Lexi Thompson, who helped her in all aspects of the event. They played golf with St. Andrews Country Club members throughout the day, conducted a golf clinic and supported the prior evening's gala dinner and auction.

After the conclusion of the event, Morgan commented: "This year's event was a huge success and I want to especially thank the generous members of St. Andrews Country Club, the Morgan & Friends Fight Cancer Committee, my personal sponsors, my extremely talented fellow LPGA members and the staff of St. Andrews Country Club, under the direction of Chief Operating Officer Craig Martin, who never fail to conduct a superior event in every aspect. Because of all of them, we were able to bring the total amount raised to fight this horrible disease to over \$2.2 million dollars over our 5 year history. We must continue and accelerate our efforts."
