

Assistant Food and Beverage Manager

This position is responsible for management of dining room service in a professional manner most pleasing to the members and their guests. It requires a high standard of appearance, hospitality, and service in personnel and cleanliness of dining room. Supervises and trains dining room staff; manages within budgetary restraints.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Works with Director of Food and Beverage in furthering the goals and policies of Wilderness Country Club.
- 2. Investigates and resolves food and beverage quality and service complaints.
- 3. Takes reservations and creates floor plans based on anticipated guest count.
- 4. Responsible for assigning sections and creating room diagrams for meal periods and events.
- 5. Books and creates BEO's for events, luncheons and parties with members.
- 6. Greets and escorts members to tables.
- 7. Assures that effective orientation and training for new staff and professional development activities for experienced staff are implemented.
- 8. Assures that pre-opening, side work and closing duties are assigned and completed as required for servers, bartenders and bussers.
- 9. Coordinates food service involving communication between kitchen and service staff.
- 10. Supervises to help assure proper service and takes orders when necessary.
- 11. Direct AM or PM pre-meal meetings with service staff (relating to menu changes, specials, BEO's and policy changes of the Club).
- 12. Assists with the development, pricing and printing of all food and beverage menus.
- 13. Assists with Jonas POS programming
- 14. Assures that the Dining Room and other Club areas are secure and locked at the end of the business day.
- 15. Keeps appropriate records of daily count and receiving liquor orders.
- 16. Takes liquor inventory.
- 17. Helps order liquor and linen.
- 18. Make center pieces for dining room tables.
- 19. Performs any other duties as required by Director of Food and Beverage.
