About the Role

The **Director of Facilities** serves as a strategic business partner within the Club, responsible for the planning, coordination, and execution of all facilities-related operations. The ideal candidate will develop and maintain preventive maintenance plans, establish long-term capital replacement schedules, and ensure all facility needs are met within the Club's financial framework.

As a leader, the Director will continue to elevate the Club's strong culture of teamwork, working closely with operational departments to support a high-functioning, service-driven environment. This individual will play a key role in maintaining the excellence and efficiency expected by members and staff, especially during the Club's current renovation and expansion.

The Director reports directly to the **Assistant General Manager** and will lead all day-to-day operations for maintenance, housekeeping, and facilities services. This includes setting priorities, managing supervisors, and overseeing all trades within the department—carpentry, painting, plumbing, electrical, HVAC, and grounds care. Experience in overseeing construction project managers and working with contractors during capital projects is highly desired.



Key Responsibilities

- Act as the owner's representative on all capital building and renovation projects
- Oversee day-to-day facilities operations, including HVAC, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, lighting, and preventative maintenance
- Lead a team of skilled tradespeople and supervisors; provide hiring, training, and performance management
- Collaborate with leadership on long-term planning for asset replacement, capital improvements, and infrastructure upgrades
- Maintain compliance with federal, state, and local codes and safety regulations
- Perform regular property inspections; ensure timely and effective issue resolution
- Manage and coordinate all external contractors, vendors, and project teams
- Maintain accurate records for inspections, permits, maintenance schedules, and safety documentation
- Monitor departmental budgets and provide monthly financial analysis (P&L responsibility)
- Promote a collaborative and high-performance culture aligned with Club values and member expectations
- Participate in weekly executive and operational meetings; attend relevant committee meetings

- Bachelor's degree in Facilities Management, Engineering, Construction, or related field (or equivalent experience)
- State of Florida General Contractor license preferred
- Deep knowledge of building systems, vendor management, and operational safety standards
- Experience managing complex facilities, maintenance teams, and outsourced contractors
- Strong communication, project management, and budgeting skills
- Proficiency with CMMS or other maintenance tracking software
- Familiarity with Florida building codes, permitting, and construction processes
