Our charities need our help more than ever as they deal with the rising costs of goods and services. To make a worthwhile impact, we're restructuring our approach to ensure maximum impact. Thirty key vendors have generously stepped forward with a minimum donation of \$15,000 each. This substantial contribution warrants a change in our format, allowing these vendors the prime opportunity to network and engage with decision-makers from various clubs. Hence, we're inviting one decision-maker per club, specifically targeting GMs or their second in command, as they hold the reins of day-to-day operations.

These vendors, representing a diverse range of industries including construction, food purveyors, wine/liquor suppliers, and more, will participate in the tournament alongside 3-4 decision-makers. Subsequently, they will have the opportunity to socialize with the remaining decision-makers during dinner, maximizing their chance to network and foster valuable connections.

The committee has decided to encourage maximum participation from you as the decision-maker, you have the flexibility to choose the amount you'd like to pay to participate.
