Position Overview

Jonathan's Landing Golf Club is seeking a Network Administrator to join their dynamic team within their premier South Florida private club. The Network Administrator is responsible for managing the day-to-day enterprise computer environment by identifying network requirements, installing hardware and software upgrades, monitoring network performance and escalating problems to vendors, maintaining the data infrastructure and security access (including email and internet), establishing network specifications, evaluating software upgrades and alternative solutions, implementing new software roll-outs, video security surveillance system, as well as managing to an annual budget.

Position Requirements

 Establishes network requirements and specifications by conferring with end users, analyzes workflow, access to information and security requirements.

- Installs and maintains new software and hardware including network servers, routers and firewalls; network security systems; surveillance systems and backup/disaster recovery procedures.
- Evaluates network for performance issues including availability, utilization and throughput; planning and executing the selection, installation, configuration, and testing of equipment; defining network policies and procedures; establishing connections and firewalls.
- Manages manufacturer's representative's installation of new computer equipment; exercise total responsibility for routine installation or modification projects; assist in repairing, installing and testing complex pieces of equipment or local area networks.
- Troubleshoots repairs, maintains, installs, and performs testing activities on various computer equipment, peripherals, data communication, and computer network systems.
- Develops and maintains software and hardware inventory and tracking systems; develops inventory lists and order, stocks, and stores electronic components.
- Assembles, installs, configures and tests computer equipment, workstations and POS terminals.
- Prepare and submit vendor warranty claims, parts, and documentation associated with warranty repairs.
- Provides support to users relating to both hardware and software problems in their workstation environment.
- Performs preventive maintenance for computer, data communication, and/or peripheral equipment; tests and adjusts to appropriate standards.
- Maintains computer network documentation and updates computer maintenance manuals.
