POSITION OVERVIEW

The Clubhouse Manager is ultimately responsible for club-wide Food and Beverage Service operations, including A la carte dining, member events, and banquet operations throughout all outlets on the property. The Clubhouse Manager oversees dining areas to ensure a smooth and consistent experience of service standards, high levels of member and guest satisfaction, quality food products, and exemplary service in conjunction with dining room staff, Beverage, and Culinary departments. The Clubhouse Manager exhibits a high energy, enthusiastic, hands-on approach and understands that on-the-floor member engagement is essential in this position. The Clubhouse Manager must motivate and inspire staff members across multiple operating departments within their purview, including Housekeeping, Valet, and Front Desk. The Clubhouse Manager will be heavily involved in enhancing the club-wide service culture and developing the member experience across the Club. This position will work very closely with the Club Manager and applicable department heads to execute high levels of member and team satisfaction.

JOB DUTIES

- Assist in the management of the hospitality operation including Banquet and A la carte food & beverage, pool, housekeeping, valet, safety, and security operations.
- Responsible for staff hiring, training, mentoring, scheduling, and management.
- Have a passion and aptitude for teaching, training, and developing educational programs for all food service personnel, working as necessary with the managers directly responsible for those operations. Be a champion for the Club's Vision.
- Ensure that team members clearly understand performance expectations and that assigned tasks are reasonable, well-conceived, and appropriately conveyed.
- Develop and implement marketing programs with the Communications Manager to increase dining room, lounge, banquet, and general participation in F&B-related activities.
- Upholds high levels of service standards through daily interactions with membership and our staff
- Deliver performance appraisals and the productive coaching/counseling of staff as needed.
- Work closely with the Club Manager to assure adherence to the approved budget and business plans, the accuracy of data and good member relations.
- Maintain the dining point of sale system and train staff on the same.
- Possesses vision and takes action to evolve programming in food & beverage.
- Leads the monthly food & beverage inventory process.
- Participates in the annual budgeting process with the Club Manager
- Support the Club Manager by leading F&B initiatives as well as the execution of future and current development projects, providing operational experience, guidance, and leadership.
- Attend and participate in Club Committees as needed
